



VERIFYING ASSURANCE STATUS – wording that should be included in the markets entry form if they are relying on a farmers’ self declaration.

The following wording (or similar) should be included on either the Sales Entry Form or be included as a separate form that attaches to the entry form. The form/ statement must be completed for every time a vendor presents livestock for sale.
